Your customers might have questions about Avios like:

Q. Why did Avios replace BA Miles?

International Airlines Group (IAG) is growing and we wanted a reward currency that could grow too. By using a shared currency across all IAG reward programmes, we can reduce costs and offer our members more ways to collect and speend Avios.

Q. How many Avios do I need for a reward flight?

It depends where you want to fly. We've split the world into nine Zones, each with its own Avios fare. For example, you'll need 9,000 Avios for an economy flight to Zone 1, 15,000 Avios for Zone 2 and 20,000 for Zone 3.

Q. Do I pay airline taxes, fees and surcharges when I book a reward flight with my Avios?

Yes. However, we pay them for you if you're a Regular Collector flying to Zone 1-3 – all you pay is the Avios fare plus E27 pp. That's what we call our Reward Flight Saver, and you get it if you've collected at least 1 Avios in the past 12 months.

Q. How do I book a reward flight with my Avids?

You can book online at www.ba.com/redeem. You'll need your membership number and password to log in to you online account.

Q. Can I collect Avios with more than one reward programme?

Yes. You can be a member of all IAG reward programmes and collect Avios with each. You can transfer Avios between British Airways Executive Club, Iberia Plus and Avios UK accounts if they're registered under the same name.

Q. I'm a member of British Airways Executive Club and Avios UK, which programme should I use to collect Avios on a flight?

If you're a frequent flyer, or flying in any cabin other than economy, we suggest you use British Airways Executive Club – so you add to your 'Tier Points'. If you're not a frequent flyer, it's best to use Avios UK.

O. Can I collect Avios on a flight Eve already taken?

Yes. A British Airways Executive Club member can claim their Avios online up to six months after taking an eligible British Airways flight. And Avios members can call us on EXEX XXX WIX within six months of their inbound flight.
